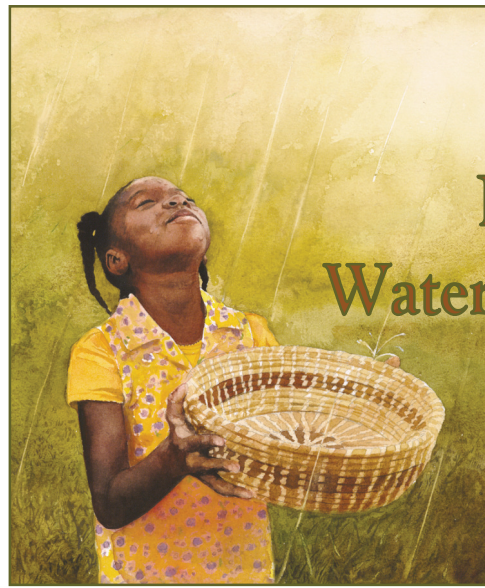

ABOUT E.B. LEWIS A graduate of Temple University's Tyler School of Art, E.B. Lewis is a nationally known artist and illustrator who has taught watercolor workshops throughout the country. His work is part of major private collections and has been exhibited in galleries across the United States. He has illustrated 50 children's books and won numerous awards including the 2003 Coretta Scott King Award and a 2005

Caldecott Honor Award. Lewis currently teaches illustration and pictorial foundations at the University of the Arts in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, and is a member of the Society of Illustrators in New York City. He maintains a second home in the Charleston, South Carolina area, and his work can be viewed at the Wells Gallery in that city.
